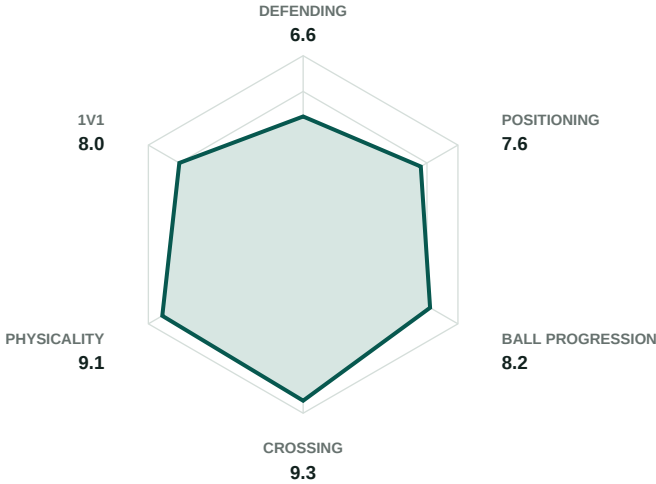

Excellent left-footed technique, especially crossing and dead-ball delivery. Comfortable progressing from wide or interior areas and capable of shooting or playing incisive passes.

PHYSICAL

8.2 / 10

Excellent engine and repeated up-and-down running. Covers large distances and sustains attacking involvement; his physical impact comes more from endurance than power.

TACTICAL

8.6 / 10

Attack-minded full-back who advances early and can move inside to progress play. His aggressive positioning can leave space behind, while defensive passivity remains a clear development area.

PSYCH / SOCIAL

8.5 / 10

Competitive and responsible. Takes ownership on set plays, shows leadership qualities as captain and displays a strong willingness to influence the game.

SCOUT'S NOTE

I really like this player. His influence on the game reminds me of Leighton Baines at Everton around 2014/15. De Blok offers excellent set-piece delivery, strong endurance, competitiveness, leadership and many attacking resources. Defensively, however, he can be passive and over-commit going forward. This area must improve if he is to compete consistently at the highest level.
